

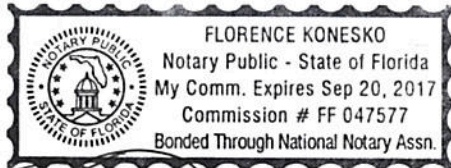


for the purpose of giving interested persons an opportunity to be heard on the proposed issuance by the Authority of its Multifamily Housing Revenue Governmental Lender Notes to be issued in one or more series (the "Notes") to finance the acquisition and rehabilitation of a 178-unit multifamily housing project known as River Trace Apartments Project and the acquisition and rehabilitation of 40 single family homes that shall be utilized as rental property and known as the Manatee Pond Apartment Homes Project, in the aggregate principal amount of not exceeding \$25,000,000. The River Trace Project is located at 2710 River Trace Circle, Bradenton, Florida 34208 and the Manatee Pond Apartment Homes Project is located at 1449 17th Street, Circle E, Bradenton, Florida 34208. The proposed owner of both Projects (as defined below) is Bradenton Leased Housing Associates III, LLLP, a Minnesota limited liability limited partnership (the "Borrower"). The Notes will be payable solely from the revenues of the River Trace Project and the Manatee Pond Apartment Homes Project (collectively, the "Projects"). The Notes will not constitute an indebtedness of the Authority, Manatee County, Florida (the "County"), the State of Florida (the "State") or any political subdivision of the State within the meaning of any constitutional or statutory debt limitation or restriction. The Authority has no taxing power.

At such meeting, persons will be given an opportunity to express their views, both orally and through written statements which are submitted to the Authority on or before the public hearing. Should any person decide to appeal any decision made by the Authority, he will need a record of the proceedings and may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record must include testimony and evidence upon which the appeals may be based.

The Authority will also hold a special meeting on November 17, 2016 at the above location immediately following the Public Hearing to discuss and consider such matters as the Authority deems appropriate.

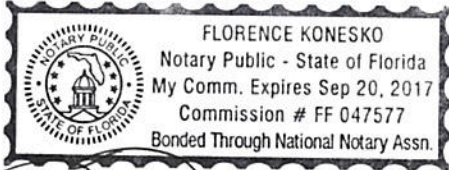
