

The Housing Finance Authority of Manatee County, Florida (the "Issuer"), hereby announces its intention to sponsor a program to reduce home loan financing costs within Manatee County, Florida. The Issuer intends to establish a mortgage credit certificate ("MCC") program which will entitle first-time and other qualified homebuyers to a federal income tax credit (the "Program.). A tax credit is a direct reduction of taxes due under Section 25 of the Internal Revenue Code. Under the Program a homebuyer would receive an MCC entitling homebuyers to reduce their taxes by 10% to 50% (such percentage to be determined by the Issuer) of the amount of interest paid on their home loan (not to exceed \$2,000 per year if the credit perexceed centage exceeds 20%). The tax credit is available each year that the borrower continues to live in the home financed in connection with the Program.

To qualify for an MCC, federal law requires that a homebuyer satisfy each of the following quidelines:

1. Principal Residence. The homebuyer must occupy the home financed in connection with the Program as his/her principal residence within a reasonable period, not to exceed 60 days, after the financing is provided. A principal residence is a home occupied primarily for residential purposes. A principal residence does not include a home used as an investment

property, as a recreation home or a home 15% or more of the total area of which is used in a trade or business.

2. First-Time Homebuyer. Each homebuyer must be a first-time homebuyer, unless the home is in a Targeted Area or the homebuyer is a qualified veteran. Any person who has not owned a principal residence at any time during the three years prior to closing a loan financed in connection with the Program is considered a first-time homebuyer.

3. Purchase Price Limit. Under the Program, the purchase price for residences may not exceed 90% of the average area purchase price applicable to the residence is in a Targeted Area). For this purpose, the "average area purchase price" is based upon the average purchase price of single family residences determined pursuamt to applicable federal law with respect to both new and existing one-7, two-three- and four-unit residences. For residences in non-Targeted Areas, the current maximum purchase price for new and existing homes under the Program is \$275,293 (for a oneunit family residence). For Targeted Areas, the current maximum purchase price for new and existing homes under the Program is \$336,470 (for a one-unit family residence). This limit is subject to adjustment periodically.

4.New Mortgage/ No Refinancing. The mortgage loan innanced in connection with the Program is required to be a new mortgage loan and may not replace a prior mortgage loan on the home (whether or not previously repaid).

5. Income Limit. The maximum family income for a family of 2 or fewer persons may not exceed 100 percent of the applicable median family income for residences in non-Targeted Areas (120% for residences in Targeted Areas). The maximum family income for a family of 3 or more persons may not exceed 115 percent of the applicable median family income for

residences in non-Targeted Areas (140% for residences in Targeted Areas). The current limits on annual gross income for households under the Program are as follows:

Families of 1-2 persons Non-Targeted Areas \$70,300 Targeted Areas \$84,360

Families of 3 or more persons Non-Targeted Areas \$80,845 Targeted Areas \$98,420

These limits are subject to adjustment periodically. Gross income includes salary and wages, including overtime, as well as dividends, alimony, public assistance, social security, unemployment compensation and investment income.

6. One- to- Four Family Homes. The residence financed in connection with the Program must be a one-, two-, three- or four-family residence. A one-family residence includes a detached home, one unit of a duplex, a townhouse or a condominium unit. Manufactured housing or mobile homes qualify only if the unit has at least 400 square feet of living space, it is more than 102 inches wide and it is of a kind customarily used at a fixed location. If the residence is a two-, three- or four-family dence, one unit of the residence must be the principal residence of the owner of the units and (with limited exceptions) residence must have been the first occupied for residential purposes at least five years prior to closing the loan financed under with the Program. Land adjoining the residence is considered part of the residence only if it maintains the residence's liva-bility and is not, other than incidentally, a source of income to the owner.

7. Mortgage Subsidy Recapture. A recipient of an MCC may under certain circumstances be required to pay a "mortgage subsidy recapture tax." Such tax, if applicable would be due upon the sale, transfer or other disposition of your home within the first 9 years after settlement of your mortgage loan. The maximum recapture tax is the lesser of (a) 50% of the gain realized

8. Program Area. To be eligible for an MCC, the home financed in connection with the Program must be located in Manatee County. There are no federal tar-geted areas in the Program

Under the Program, MCCs will be issued to eligible borrowers on a first-come, first-served basis. The MCCs are available with any type of mortgage loan (except loans from tax-exempt bond programs), including fixed rate and ediversible rate most rate and adjustable rate mort-gage loans. Any lending institu-tion is eligible to provide mort-gage loans under the Program.
